



Driver CPC - Load Restraint Appreciation and Inspection



Course Aim

The aim of this course is to provide training for securing a load safely and provide an understanding to drivers or transport managers of their legal responsibilities for transporting a load on UK highways. This training is a key aspect of transport operations and will provide an example of best business practice.



Who Should Attend?
